
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for South Burlington Alternative Transportation Crossing Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of South Burlington, located at 180 Market Street, South Burlington, VT, 05403. The funding would be used for constructing a pedestrian and bicycle bridge and shared-use paths across I-89 at Exit 14.
