
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Town of Putney Mondon Commons Homeownership Development in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Vermont Housing and Conservation Board, located at 58 E State St. #101, Montpelier, Vermont, 05602. The funding would be used for the construction of a modular "micro-neighborhood" featuring six permanently affordable, shared equity housing units in the Town of Putney's Neighborhood Development Area. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide much needed housing in a state facing an extreme housing crisis and substantially increase affordable homeownership options in the community.
